INCOME FROM FEES, FINES, CHARGES

All charges to students shall be kept at a minimum. No student shall be caused to suffer embarrassment because of financial inability to participate in any activity or project under control of the District.

The Superintendent shall establish procedure for inspection of textbooks, furnishings and equipment and oversee preparation of a schedule of fines for lost or damaged textbooks, furnishings and/or equipment. The same schedule shall apply to nonpublic school students who lose or damage textbooks loaned to them. Collected fines shall be forwarded to the Business Administrator/Board Secretary on a timely basis.
