

LENDING OF DISTRICT-OWNED EQUIPMENT

Except as authorized by the Superintendent or contractual agreement, school equipment may not be used for outside purposes. School equipment may be loaned to staff members as authorized by the Superintendent, when such use is directly or peripherally related to their instructional responsibilities. Students may also be authorized to use such equipment in connection with their studies or extra-curricular activities. The Board also permits equipment to be loaned to other governmental agencies when specifically authorized by the Superintendent.

The Superintendent shall establish procedures to assure the borrower's responsibility to properly maintain and return all equipment.
